Course Overview: Welcome to *Microsoft® Project 2019: Introduction*. This course is designed to familiarize you with the basic features and functions of Microsoft Project Professional 2019 so you can use it effectively and efficiently in a real-world environment.

Target Student: This course is designed for a person with an understanding of project management concepts and who is responsible for creating and maintaining project plans. The course will give the student a fundamental understanding of Microsoft Project 2019 necessary to create and save project plans.

Prerequisites: To ensure your success in this course, you should have basic project management knowledge and skills.

You should also have basic knowledge and skills for using any current Windows® operating system.

Finally, you should have competency in using other Microsoft Office applications—preferably Office 2019. You can take any of the Office 2019 course offerings from CompuTrain to attain the requisite knowledge and skills.
